

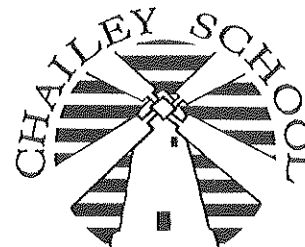

Dear Parents, Carers and Students

Year 11 Uniform - September 2010

As you are aware from previous information, there are changes being made to the school uniform requirements from September 2010. However, with the exception of girls' skirts, these do not apply to our current Year 10 students who begin their final year at Chailey this coming September as our senior year group.

For all students in Year 11, as has always been the case, they can choose to either:

- (a) continue with their current uniform of shirt, tie and jumper; or
- (b) switch to the polo shirt and sweatshirt (both with school logo) option.


There is no requirement for Year 11 students to wear a blazer but if they choose to do so then this is to be worn with the school shirt and tie (with the jumper then becoming optional). Blazers are not to be worn with the polo shirt/sweatshirt style of Year 11 uniform.

Year 11 girls from September will, in common with the rest of the school, be required to wear the revised uniform style of knee-length pleated skirt. However, to avoid additional cost for parents, girls can choose to wear their existing trousers – provided that those that they have are of the style as set out in the attached information.

A full list of compulsory and optional items for boys and girls in Year 11 is attached. Please note that we have extended our uniform outlets from two to three, with the addition of Intersport in Lewes as a stockist of Chailey School uniform. We hope this will further help parents in kitting out their youngsters for September.

CHAILEY SCHOOL BOYS' UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS FOR YEAR 11
FROM SEPTEMBER 2010

Compulsory Items - All Students

Shoes

- *Black leather or leather-like formal school shoes. Trainers, sandals, flip-flops, boots, mules or canvas shoes of any kind are not permitted. Please be advised that if girls' shoes have a heel, this should be of a safe and sensible height for moving around a busy school, including up and down stairs.*

Compulsory Items - Boys

Trousers

- *Can be purchased from our suppliers. Plain, navy blue formal school trousers; to be worn fastened above the waist. Boys are to wear trousers properly, i.e. not very low down and any belt necessary should be plain black or navy with a normal and discreet buckle. Denim or casual trousers (e.g. combat-style) are **not** permitted.*

Plain navy blue or black socks

PLUS EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS:

Option (1) – Boys – to retain current uniform

Plain pale blue tailored shirt

- *May be short or long sleeved, must be tucked in with top collar button done up. Any undergarment (e.g. vest or t-shirt) should be plain white and should **not** be visible.*

and

School striped tie

- *Must be purchased from school suppliers. This must be worn correctly, i.e. ties are to be worn tied to the neck with the top shirt button done up and the broad side of the tie uppermost, which should reach down to the waist, i.e. not the current trend for a 'shortened' style.*

and

V-neck navy blue school jumper with logo

- *Can be purchased from our suppliers*

OR

Option (2) – Boys – to wear Year 11 uniform (still available for 2010-2011)

Plain navy blue school polo shirt with logo

- *Can be purchased from our suppliers. Any undergarment (e.g. vest or t-shirt) should be plain white and should **not** be visible.*

and

Plain navy blue school sweatshirt with logo

- *Can be purchased from our suppliers*

CHAILEY SCHOOL GIRLS' UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS FOR YEAR 11
FROM SEPTEMBER 2010

Compulsory Items - All Students

Shoes

- *Black leather or leather-like formal school shoes. Trainers, sandals, flip-flops, boots, mules or canvas shoes of any kind are not permitted. Please be advised that if girls' shoes have a heel, this should be of a safe and sensible height for moving around a busy school, including up and down stairs.*

Compulsory Items - Girls

Knee-length navy blue multiple pleated school skirt

- *Can be purchased from our suppliers (Broadbridge's or Intersport only until October 2010)*

OR

Plain navy blue girls' trousers

- *Can be purchased from our suppliers. Trousers should not have excessively wide flares or be the very tight-fitting 'skinny' style. Leggings or trousers which have the appearance of leggings are **not** permitted. Denim or casual trousers (e.g. combat-style) are **not** permitted.*

Plain navy blue or black tights/socks

- *Flesh-coloured tights or plain white socks may be worn in the summer*

PLUS EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING OPTIONS:

Option (1) - Girls - to retain current uniform

Plain pale blue tailored blouse with no tie

- *May be short or long sleeved. Should be school style **not** fashion type. These are to be worn properly fastened, i.e. not the current trend to wear the blouse as open and low-cut as possible. Any undergarment (e.g. vest or t-shirt) should be plain white and should **not** be visible.*

and

V-neck navy blue school jumper with logo

- *Can be purchased from our suppliers*

OR

Option (2) - Girls - to wear Year 11 uniform (still available for 2010-2011)

Plain navy blue school polo shirt with logo

- *Can be purchased from our suppliers. Any undergarment (e.g. vest or t-shirt) should be plain white and should **not** be visible.*

and

Plain navy blue school sweatshirt with logo

- *Can be purchased from our suppliers*

PE Kit – no change to requirements for all Year 11 students

White T-shirt with school logo
Plain navy blue shorts or skirt
Navy blue football socks
Navy/sky blue reversible rugby shirt
Plain navy blue tracksuit or navy blue sweatshirt and jogging bottoms
White sports socks
Trainers
Shin pads
Football boots required for extra-curricular football (other students requiring boots will be notified by PE staff as necessary)

Jewellery

Jewellery is not appropriate for school. However, one pair of gold ear studs and one small signet ring and a watch may be worn but, under Health and Safety regulations, these must be removed for PE, Technology and other practical subjects. We do not accept any other forms of piercing. Covering new piercings with tape is not an option. No other jewellery may be worn (i.e. necklaces, bracelets etc).

Parents are requested to ensure that any items that are not purchased from our suppliers match the stated uniform guidelines. Please refer to our school website or to our suppliers (Broadbridges in Haywards Heath; Intersport in Lewes or 'Get It 4 Schools' online) or your child's Student Support Manager should you require further clarification.
